FAQ:

Why should I spend \$25.00 to become an affiliate member?

An affiliate membership allows you to all the benefits of a company member. You will receive newsletters, weekly News To Use, and all corresponded via email to keep you up to date on the activities of the association.

I'm already getting the newsletters, so why do I have to pay the \$25.00?

Once the Board approved the affiliate membership category, anyone that was receiving a newsletter other than the primary member of a member company, will no longer receive this service.

Why did the Board of Directors make this new membership category?

For several reasons. One it will increase our membership numbers. For every affiliate membership 1/2 spike credit is given. It adds a small amount to our budget to pay for the direct costs of sending the newsletters, faxes, etc. And most importantly, it gives the Affiliate member the recognition they deserve as a member. It is also a recognized membership category of the National Association of Home Builders and there are many benefits available to you as an Affiliate Member!

If I personally pay for the Affiliate Membership and I leave my current employer, am I still considered an Affiliate Member?

Only if your next job is with a member of our association in good standing. The Affiliate Membership is non transferable if your employer pays the \$25.00 unless your employer, in writing states it is a benefit you can take with you should you leave their employment.

I am already very involved with the Flagler HBA, why are you making me now pay \$25.00? When a company joins our association, their main contact person is usually the owner, President, etc. They are the direct contact for our HBA staff to send vital information about the association. They sometimes are not the person that becomes involved in the association and they usually do not wish for their name to be removed as the main contact. We recognized the fact that many of our most active participants may not be the direct contact for their company. An Affiliate membership allows you to personally be a member, not just a 'dependant' of your parent company.

• Note: The \$25.00 annually is used to offset the costs of providing services, a portion is also sent to NAHB for your National Membership dues.
